



CHESS COMPETITION Inter-school teams B and C Grade competition at Grange Primary

Dear Students, Parents and Caregivers,

An Inter-school B and C Grade Chess Competition will be facilitated at Grange Primary School on Tuesdays in the Yr 6/7 building known as The Louise Moss building, from 4pm - 5pm, in Terms Two and Three.

The competition will be organised and run by Mr Alan Goldsmith from Knights and Bytes. Alan is heavily involved in The South Australian Junior Chess League and visits many schools in the Adelaide region providing chess training and competitions for classes of students. He is also involved in running interschool competitions such as the one we are promoting in this letter. This competition runs over two terms and involves seven matches, all played at Grange School.

The Primary week dates are:

Term 2: 10th May, 24th May, 14th June, 28th June,

Term 3: 2nd August, 16th August, 30th August.

Most of the matches are a fortnight apart but allowances have had to be made for public holidays etc. Depending on the numbers of teams, there will probably be 2 separate groups.

Each team consists of 4 players and most of the players will be new to playing competitive chess - so it will be gentle, easy fun. Teams will be arranged in order of Year level. The players cannot switch between teams but there can be reserves for each team. The winning team in each competition will take part in the Finals in Term Three.

The cost to compete for the season is just \$15 per student. Students from schools outside of Grange Primary can pay on their first visit using the tear off form below. If you intend to include your child in the competition please let either myself or Alan know so we can arrange teams before the commencement date.
