CANTEEN NEWS

We have sent home a 2017 price list with students today. Prices will remain unchanged from 2016 for the time being. MEDICINES

The school staff are not able to administer medicines without a written note clearly indicating the dosage required and frequency, and preferably from a Doctor. We are not able to administer any form of pain relief tablets. If your child is in pain then we will call you as it would be better for them to be at home where you can give relief and monitor the results. We also need Doctor's notes for students with any medical conditions (eg. Asthma, Epipen). These notes or Action Plans, tell us what the symptoms are we need to look for and what actions to take in response. **All Asthma action plans and Anaphylaxis plans are required to be updated each year, this is a DECD requirement. Please supply these to the Front Office at your earliest convenience. Please note - Children will be unable to attend excursions etc without an updated plan.**

As we do not have medical officers on site, we will only work to written Action Plans. For your child's safety, please bring them in to the Front Office for safe keeping.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP POINTS

The Charles Sturt Council have designated some areas around our school that have **no parking allowed**. These areas have been set aside for safety reasons so that drivers can see our young people who might run across the road. (Areas along both North Street and Cheadle Street). Please remember, do not park in any of these areas, as it will assist with the safety of our students. We also ask parents to not park in the Cheadle Street Staff car park and the North Street car park as this is used by delivery trucks and vans during the day, so can be very hazardous to children. The 2 minute 'kiss & drop' zone is just that, and the **council regularly patrols this area and issues fines** to cars that are parked within the area for longer than the 2 minutes.

LOST PROPERTY

Please make sure that all belongings sent along to school are **clearly labelled** with children's names. The amount of unlabelled jumpers, water bottles etc. that are left behind at the end of each week is quite staggering!

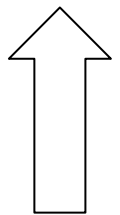
We have vacancies in Under 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15 and 16s if you are interested or know anyone looking to play footy at the Sharks this season please come along.

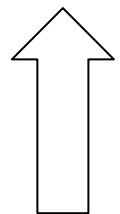
