The student report shows your child's results on a sliding scale indicating their achievement compared to National and School Averages. The student summary shows how your child answered all questions and compares this to the school and national percentages. If you have any questions related to your child's results please see the class teacher.

As a school we look at trends and analyse the results to help us with future planning. These tests form only part of our assessment of your child, other data collected throughout the year is used to give us a clear understanding of how your child is progressing.
