### 2018 Parent Opinion Survey

A good sample of 58 parents participated in the school's annual parent opinion survey. Overall, parents reported a high level of satisfaction with the school. 91% of parents agreed with *teachers at this school expect my child to do his or her best* and 95% agreed with *I can talk with my child's teachers about my concerns*. Parent perception slipped with the statement *my child's learning needs are being met at this school* with 69% in agreement which provides us with an area to look further into.

This performance has traditionally been called the Christmas Concert at Fulham North. However lessons leading up to it are inclusive of all celebrations in our multicultural community.

The Junior Primary classes will be hearing the celebration stories surrounding Eid, Hanukah, Diwali and Christmas, as well as Holi since it is from the Holi Festival that last term's colour run originated. The students will then select their classes' favourite songs to perform to you. There will also be songs not associated with celebrations but which the students wish to learn and perform to the Fulham North community.

The middle and upper primary students will perform some Christmas parodies. The rest will be non-celebratory items that are light-hearted in nature for all to enjoy and have a giggle with. Choreographed dance items will be the primary focus for most of the performances, with a couple integrating dramatic elements.

### **INDONESIAN DAY**

On Friday, 9 November, (week 4) we will be running an Indonesian Day at Fulham North to celebrate Indonesian language and culture. I have been working closely with the Year 6/7 students on some different activities that they will be facilitating for the Junior and Middle Primary students.


