#### Dear Families, Principal Position

It is with great pleasure that I announce that I have been reappointed for the first 6 months of 2019, giving the school some leadership continuity. I look forward to continuing in my capacity as Principal of Fulham North Primary School. During the first half of next year, Education Director Chris Sheldon will be running a process to fill the position substantially for the next five years.

#### Christmas Concert

We are looking forward to our Christmas Concert on Tuesday, 4 December on the school oval. It is a 6.15pm start, so we suggest families start gathering on the oval from 6.00pm. It is designed to be a relaxing and enjoyable atmosphere. The weather looks promising so it should be a

great night. Students have been working hard in their Performing Arts lessons. Many of you have ordered pizzas (orders due 5pm Friday) and the Governing Council will be operating a sausage sizzle at \$2.50. We also request that parents and carers support our performers by keeping their children off of the playground by the stage.

#### Computer Scheme

Leadership, staff and Governing Council have been exploring the notion of an individual computer scheme, similar to many secondary schools and some primary schools across the state. This is a co-ownership arrangement with a laptop in which students can take home every day, and effectively purchase the computer over time so it is owned when the student finishes school.

Parents of current Year 2 to 6 students will be surveyed next week, as we are seeking to introduce this for Year 3 to 7 students, possibly for next year. Please note, that if we do introduce such a scheme, it will be optional and purely voluntary.

### Change in School Times in 2019

Next year, our school times will change to six lessons per day of 50 minutes each, with an introduction of a morning home group and continuing with the lunch eating time. School will commence each day at 8.40am which is current expectation. However, **school will be concluding each day at 3.00pm, back from the current 3.10pm.** This means students will receive 1600 minutes of instruction each week, which is in line with the Department for Education's expectation.
