This year's National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy will take place during Weeks 3 and 4 of this term for all students in years 3, 5 and 7. There is a significant difference this year, with all students required to complete the testing on-line, with the exception of the Year 3 writing component.

The test areas are Language Conventions, Writing, Reading, and Numeracy.

The tests are run over a few days and students have been prepared for the testing by their class teachers so that they are familiar with the type of test and are confident to do their best on the day.

*Although we encourage all students to participate and do their best to show what they know, parents may withdraw their child from one or more of the tests by contacting their class teacher.*
