Teaching and Learning

PAT Results

Student Progressive Achievement Testing (PAT) results are in, with good levels of achievement. The testing is conducted with all students from years 2-7. This year, 91% of Fulham North students met the Standard of Educational Achievement (SEA) in Maths and 88% met SEA in Reading. Overall, the school averages achieved were above the national median which is a positive result. Primary teachers have begun unpacking these results in their learning teams. This data will now be used to further extend and challenge students.

Curriculum support

At our recent pupil free day, teachers had the opportunity to explore new curriculum support documents released by the Department for Education. In pursuit of a world class education system, an analysis of high performing school system and review of our current curriculum support was

conducted by the department. The review found that the further support for curriculum delivery would strengthen our system. The documents explored by teachers include planning support documents, scope and sequence documents and units of work. We look forward to continuing to strengthen our practice in this space.

I'd like to officially announce **Tara Hendry's** appointment as Assistant Principal of Fulham North for the next 3 years. 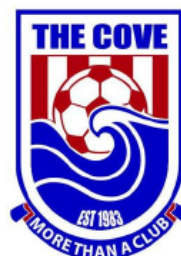
